Chairman's Announcement:** Maurice Adams, formerly Duchy tenant of Manor Farm, died on August 23rd aged 91½, having been in declining health for the past few years; Maurice was a towering figure in all respects, taking over the tenancy of Manor Farm in 1971 from his uncle, Edwin Glide, and thereafter became a major contributor to the National Farmers Union, being sometime Somerset Chairman and a member of one of the NFU's national committees. He also served for many years on the parish's Parochial Church Council and chaired one of the 2004/2005 Parish Plan sub-committees (which he limited to two meetings, - one to determine actions, the other to review results). Maurice was a man of few words but of great wisdom, and has been much mourned by people of the parish and the wider farming community. The Council extends its condolences to the Adams family, particularly, Sylvia, Justin and Giles, still living in the parish.
